- Minor "Land": Relative Minor/Major (differing from parallel)
- Identify/Notate 3 types of Minor Scales and Minor Key Signatures
- Interval Identification and Notation
- Intervallic Inversion
- Compound Intervals
- **Triad Identification and Notation:** (Major, Minor, Diminished, and Augmented)
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- **7**th **Chord Identification and Notation:** (Major-Major 7or Major7, Minor-Minor7 or Minor7, Major-Minor7 or Dominant 7, Fully Diminished 7, & Half-Diminished 7)
- **Triad Inversion:** (Root Position, 1st Inversion, 2nd Inversion)
- 7th Chord Inversion: (Root Position, 1st Inversion, 2nd Inversion, and 3rd Inversion)
- Alterations
- Ear Training: All intervals from P1 to P15
